Our Lions Club, along with Lions International, wishes to support the youth of the world and make them aware of the importance of giving of their time and talents in community service.

The Scholarship Funds are being made available to high school graduates (or equivalent) who have lived in the Camarillo/Somis area for at least the last year and are planning on furthering their formal education. The scholarship recipients will be selected, in part, by the following criteria: involvement in community service, academics and attitude. We encourage you to make all qualifying seniors aware of our Lions Club Scholarship(s) and assist any student, that you feel is well rounded, community service minded and deserving of our consideration, in submitting a qualified application. Graduates who plan on attending a Junior College, Trade School or other accredited Institutions are strongly encouraged to apply.

Note: This year's scholarship recipients will be selected from Applicants having a combined 2.50 — 3.65 G.P.A. (unweighted).

The Scholarship Funds, once awarded, will be made available upon receipt of enrollment documentation into a furthering educational program. The Scholarship Funds will only be available for 6 months from date of high school graduation.

Completed applications must be submitted to school personnel responsible for handling Scholarships.

April 21, 2023

Scholarship applications must be received by the Lions Club Scholarship Chairman.

Mission of Lions Club International

The Camarillo/Somis – Pleasant Valley Lions Club is one of more than 47,000 Lions Clubs in over 200 countries or geographic regions belonging to Lions Clubs International. Lions International objectives include: creating and fostering a spirit of understanding among peoples of the world, promoting the principles of good government, good citizenship and to encourage service minded men and women to serve their communities.

Focus

The Pleasant Valley Lions Club Scholarships are being made available to students wishing to further their education. The applicant must exhibit a positive attitude, demonstrate service to others and will be graduating with an overall 2.50 to 3.65 G.P.A. (unweighted).

Scholarship Awards : \$ 5,000 Maximum

To qualify for a Camarillo/Somis – Pleasant Valley Lions Club Scholarship, an applicant must be a graduating senior, or will have earned a GED by June 2023. They also must have attended their respective school for the entire 2022 -2023 school year and must have lived in the Camarillo/Somis Area, within one of the following Zip Codes: **93010, 93011, 93012 and 93066.**

Preliminary Selection Criteria

Scholarship applications must be **Typed** with **All** of the following criteria being addressed and submitted for judging. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The areas of emphasis and weight for judging are indicated by the following percentages:

- Community Service — 30 %
- Work experience — 10%
- Completeness and overall appearance of application — 10 %
- Written Essay — 25 %
- Future educational and career goals — 5%
- Academic standing documentation (a copy of transcript) — 5 %
- Two letters of recommendation — 15 %

Letters must be addressed to the Pleasant Valley Lions Club

Letters are to reflect on the character and integrity of the applicant.

One (1) Letter (maximum) can be submitted from school related personnel (teachers, coaches and counselors). Letters from the following: youth groups, work, service organizations and neighbors, etc. are acceptable.

Final Selection Criteria:

Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected on all of the above criteria. A personal interview may be required in making the final selection.

Application Submission Deadlines:

Applications must be submitted to either the student's school counselor or career center technician by April 18, 2023 and received by the Pleasant Valley Lions Scholarship Chairman: 1553 Prima Court, Camarillo, Ca. 93010 by April 21, 2023
